
Keeping More Money in the Pockets of American Families:

County-Level Data of Savings by Extending the
Payroll Tax Cut

**A Report by the Joint Economic Committee Chairman's Staff

Summary

The payroll tax cut, which was enacted at the end of 2010, lowered the rate at which employees' earnings are taxed to fund Social Security from 6.2 percent to 4.2 percent. At the end of 2011, Congress passed a two-month stop-gap reauthorization of the two-percentage-point payroll tax cut to provide further support for the economic recovery and struggling families. The following tables provide an estimate of the median annual wage and salary per worker in each county in the 50 states and the District of Columbia. Those tables also report the additional take-home pay that each worker would receive if Congress were to reauthorize the payroll tax cut for the remaining 10 months of the year.

County-level median wage and salary income for workers with earnings are 5-year U.S. Census Bureau estimates using the 2006-2010 American Community Survey data, adjusted to reflect 2010 dollars. The data were downloaded by the Joint Economic Committee (JEC) Chairman's staff using the [American FactFinder](#), the U.S. Census Bureau's online data extraction tool.

The tables also present an estimate of what a family consisting of two earners would receive. That measure simply doubles the amount per worker in the county. The January 24, 2012 JEC report titled, "How Continuing the Payroll Tax Cut and Federal UI Benefits Will Help American Families and Support the Recovery," gives estimates of wage and salary per household by state. However, it is not feasible to replicate that household analysis at the county level with the available data. The measure from the earlier JEC report may differ significantly from the measures presented here because actual households consist of one, two, or more earners with widely differing levels of earnings. Instead, the measure reported here is meant as a simple illustration of the impact on a family that consists of two earners who make the median wage and salary within the county.
