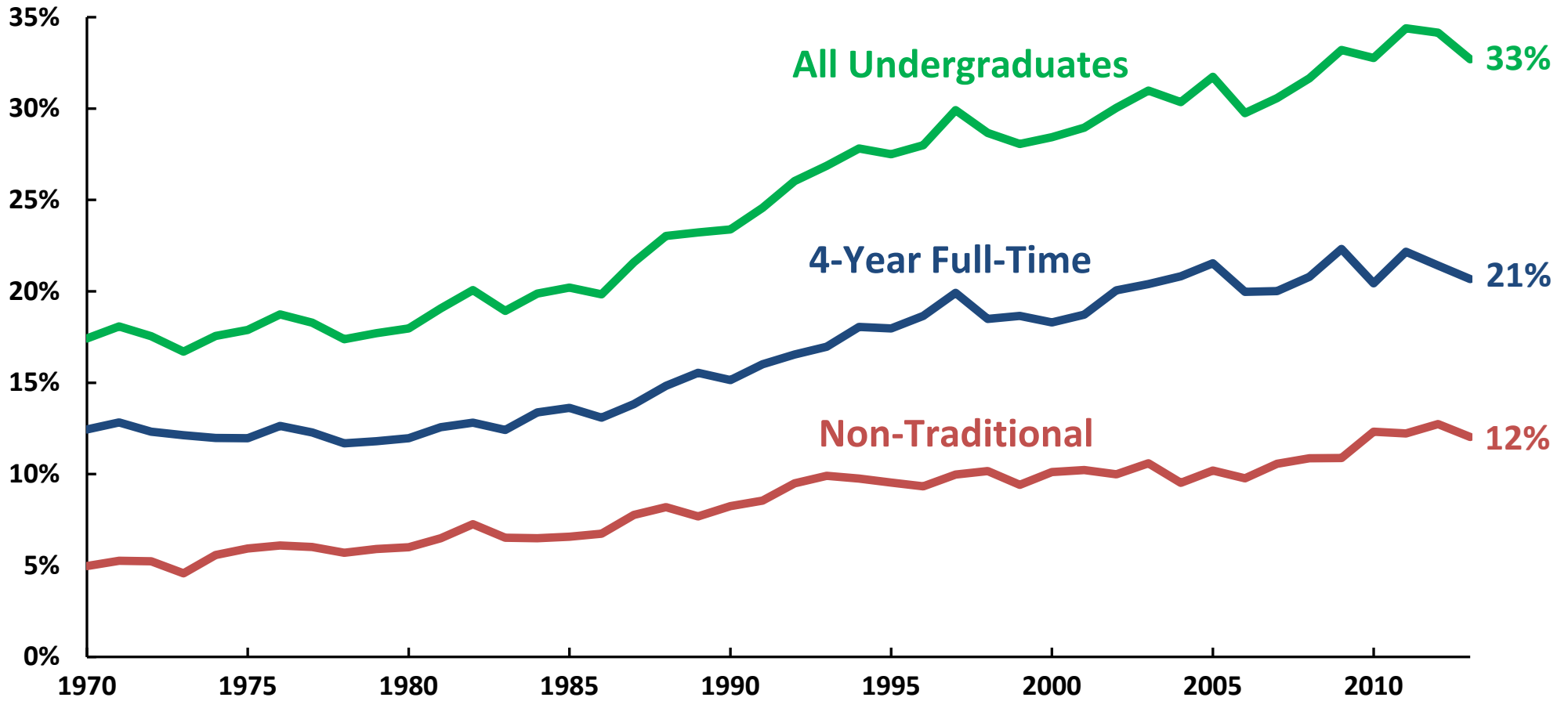


Figure 2: Increasing Share of Young Adults Enrolled in Undergraduate College
