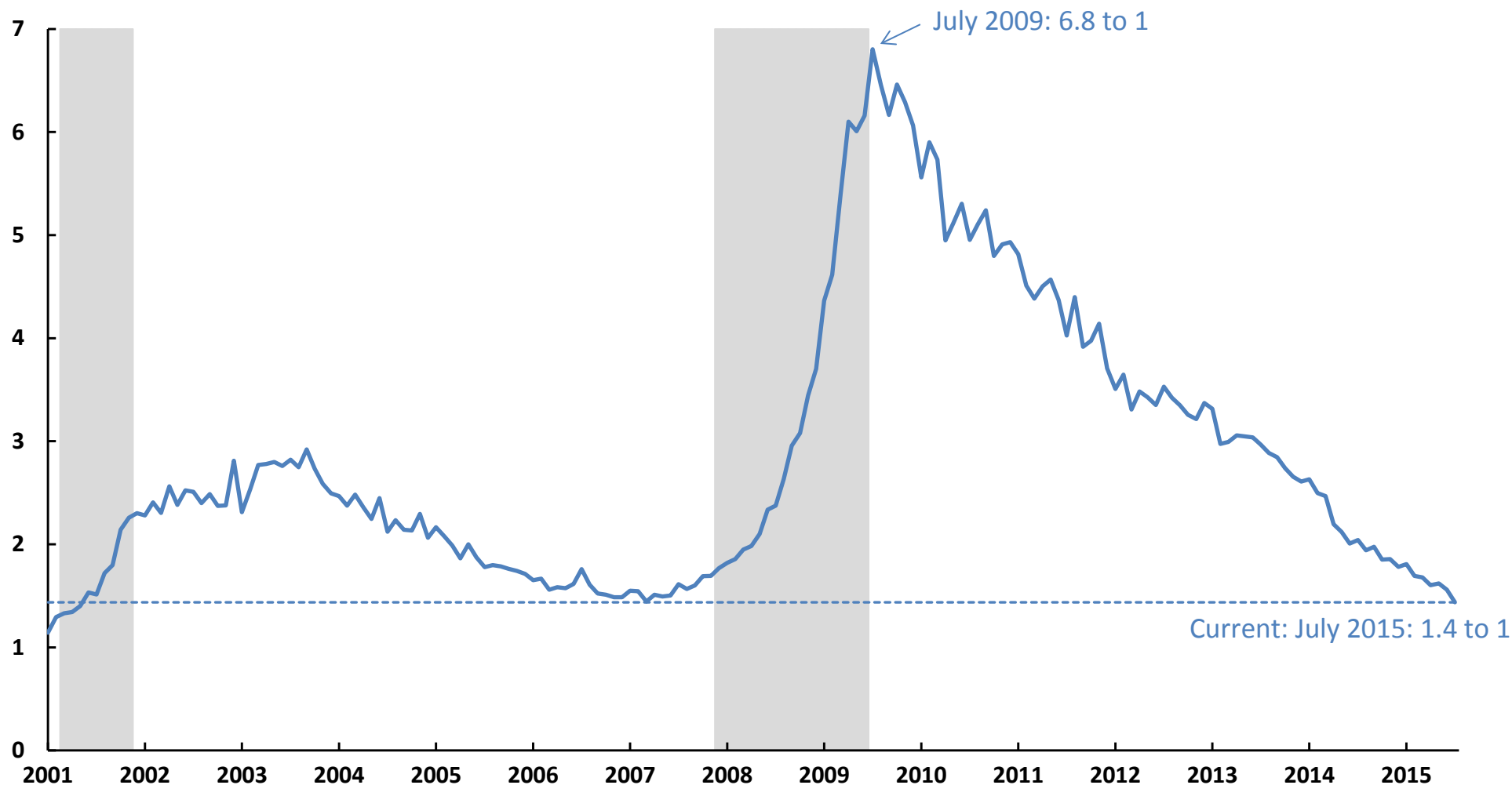


The Ratio of Unemployed Workers to Job Openings Is at Its Lowest Level Since Before the Great Recession
