

## **United States** Employment Snapshot

- In October, among the 50 states and the District of Columbia unemployment fell in 8, rose in 22, and remained unchanged in 21.
- The highest unemployment rate was 5.7 percent in **District of Columbia and Nevada**, and the lowest was 1.9 percent in **South Dakota**. Nationally, the unemployment rate remained unchanged in October.
- In October, **payroll jobs rose in 21 states and fell in 30.** The largest payroll job percent increase was 0.4 percent in **Idaho**. The largest payroll job percent decline was 1 percent in **Washington**.

## **Utah** Employment Snapshot

- In October, **Utah added 4,600 net payroll jobs** and the **unemployment rate remained unchanged at 3.5 percent**. In the prior month, Utah added 3,000 net payroll jobs.
- Over the past 12 months, Utah added 32,600 net payroll jobs and the unemployment rate rose by 0.7
  percentage points from 2.8 percent.
- Nationally, nonfarm payrolls **rose by 12,000 in October, or 0 percent.** Utah **ranks 12th** in the nation for percentage gain in nonfarm payroll employment over the past 12 months.
- In October, **Utah's private sector added 3,600 net private payroll jobs**, and over the past 12 months it added 21,200 private payroll jobs. In the prior month, Utah added 1,200 net private payroll jobs.
- In October, employment in Utah fell by 219, and over the past 12 months it fell by 14,107.
- **Utah's labor force participation rate fell to 68.3 percent** in October from 68.4 percent and **ranks 4th** in the nation. In the past 12 months, the labor force participation rate has fallen by 1.3 percentage points.
