Monthly Employment Update

Employment Situation

December 2024 | Released January 10, 2025

From November 2024 to December 2024:

- Nonfarm payroll employment increased by 256K.
 - Private sector payroll employment increased by 223K
 - Government payroll employment increased by 33K.
- The headline unemployment rate (U-3) decreased by 0.1 percentage points to 4.1 percent.
 - The broadest measure of unemployment (U-6, which adds underemployment to unemployment), decreased by 0.2 percentage points to 7.5 percent.
- The labor force participation rate (LFPR) remained unchanged at 62.5 percent.

From December 2023 to December 2024:

- For all employees on private nonfarm payrolls:
 - Average nominal weekly earnings increased by 3.63 percent.
 - Average nominal hourly earnings increased by 3.93 percent.
- For production and nonsupervisory employees on private nonfarm payrolls:
 - o Average nominal weekly earnings increased by 3.45 percent.
 - $\circ\;$ Average nominal hourly earnings increased by 3.76 percent.



Job Openings and Labor Turnover Survey

November 2024 | Released January 07, 2025

Job Openings: The total number of nonfarm job openings decreased by 259K to 8.10 million, and the rate increased by 0.1 percentage points to 4.8 percent.

- The best performing sectors were professional and business services (+273K) and financial activities (+114K).
- The worst performing sectors were information (-89K) and leisure and hospitality (-83K).

Hires: The total number of nonfarm hires decreased by 125K to 5.27 million, and the rate decreased by 0.1 percentage points to 3.3 percent.

- The best performing sectors were **leisure and hospitality** (+74K) and **information** (+9K).
- The worst performing sectors were professional and business services (-66K) and manufacturing (-39K).

Separations: The total number of nonfarm separations decreased by 180K to 5.13 million, and the rate decreased by 0.1 percentage points to 3.2 percent.

- Quits decreased by 218K to 3.06 million, and the rate decreased by 0.2 percentage points to 1.9 percent.
- Layoffs and discharges increased by 17K to 1.76 million, and the rate remained unchanged at 1.1 percent.
- Other separations decreased by 21K to 296K, and the rate remained unchanged at 0.2 percent.
